



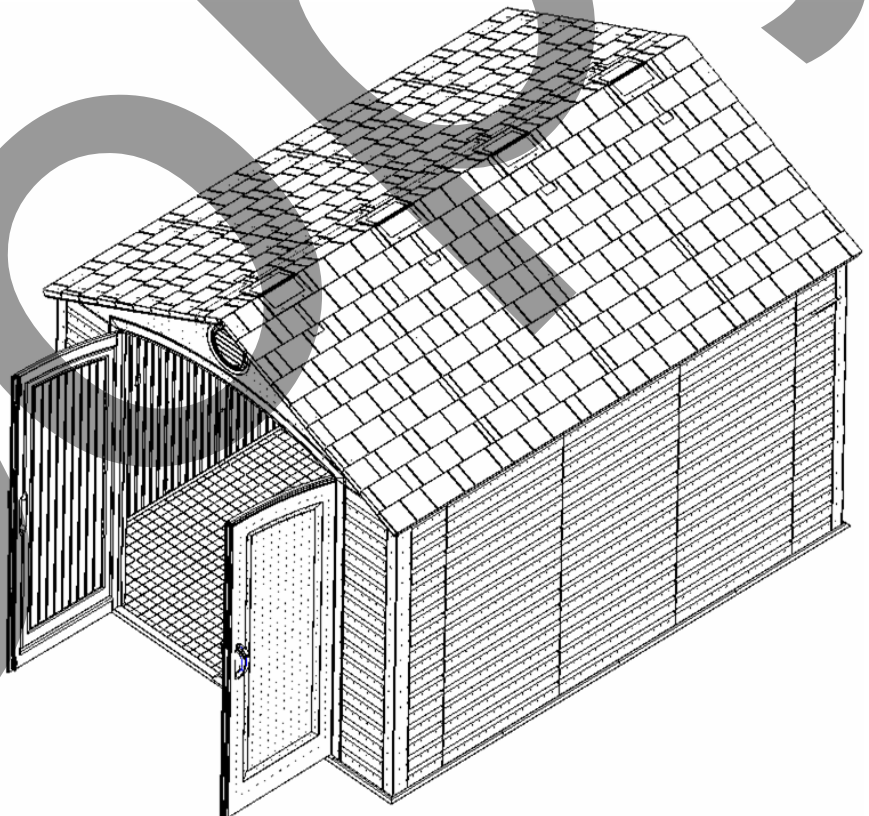

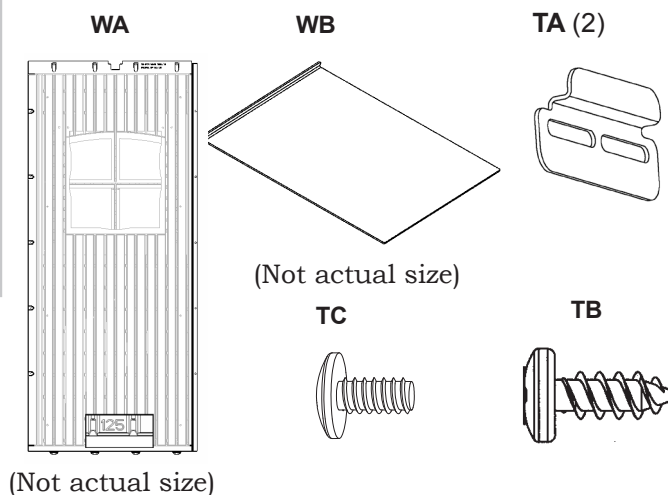

1. #2 Phillips screwdriver or Electric drill with phillips head

If You are Installing a New Shed

1. Check contents of boxes and compare to parts listed on the Parts List.
2. Follow instructions that came with your shed, but replace the wall panel that came with this kit with the unwanted wall panel that came with your shed.

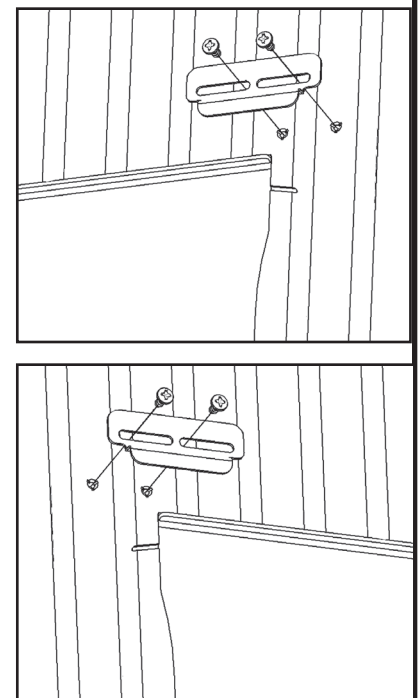
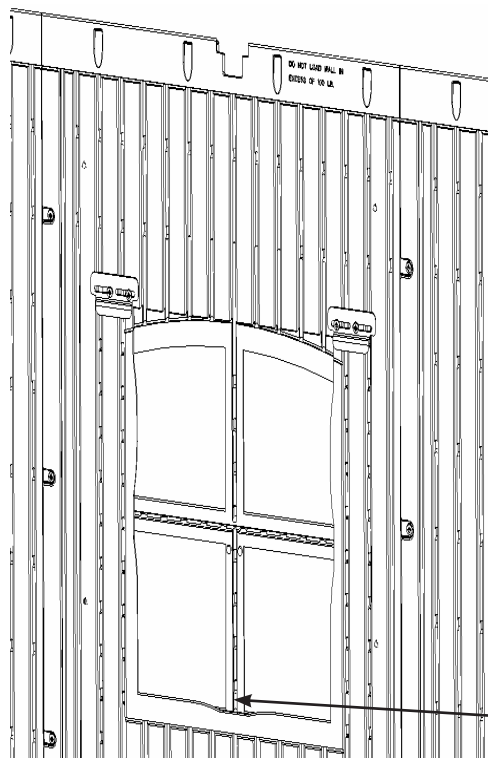
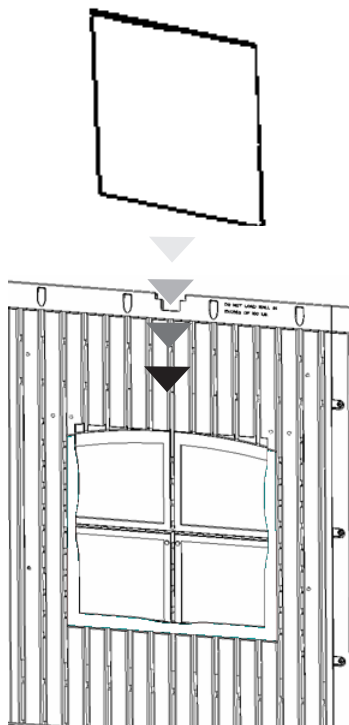
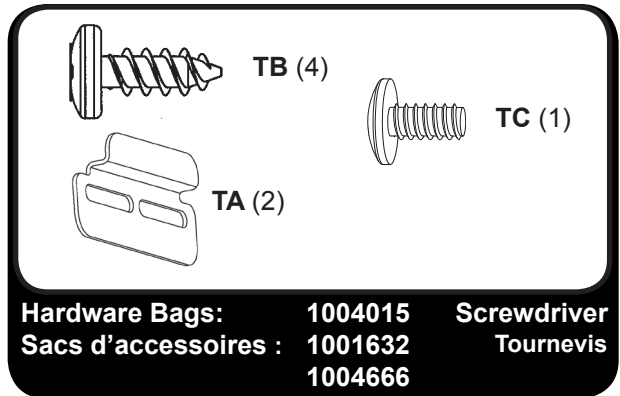
If You are Modifying an Existing Shed

1. Remove any objects from back shelves.
2. Remove any shelves, pegboards, or other objects hanging on the last two Side Wall Panels on either side.
3. Check contents of boxes and compare to parts listed on the Parts List.
4. Follow the steps in this manual.
5. If you are extending an 8' x 5' shed you will need to modify the following instructions by not removing as many parts as shown in the illustrations.

Note: You have the option to add the window wall panel to an existing shed or the option to insert the window wall panel in place of a regular wall panel on a new shed. Regardless of the option you take, you must attach the window to the panel. After attaching the window, you can proceed to the option that suits your needs.

Assemble Window

1 Remove plastic sheeting from **Window (WB)** and slide Window into slot on the **Window Wall Panel (WA)**. Attach a **Window Latch (TA)** above each corner of the Window as shown. When tightening **Screws (TB)**, be sure that Window Latches will slide freely. Do not overtighten. Insert **Screw (TC)** into the hole in the window. Set panel aside.



Place Screw (TC) in this hole to keep window from sliding up too far. Insert until flush with the window.



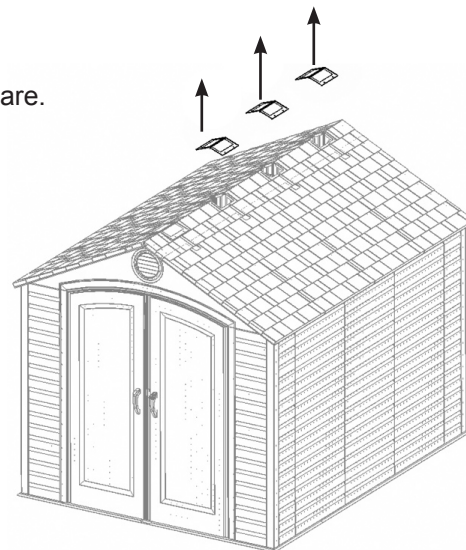
Insert window with bent edge at top and pointing away from the wall.

Option 1: Add Window Wall Panel to Existing Shed

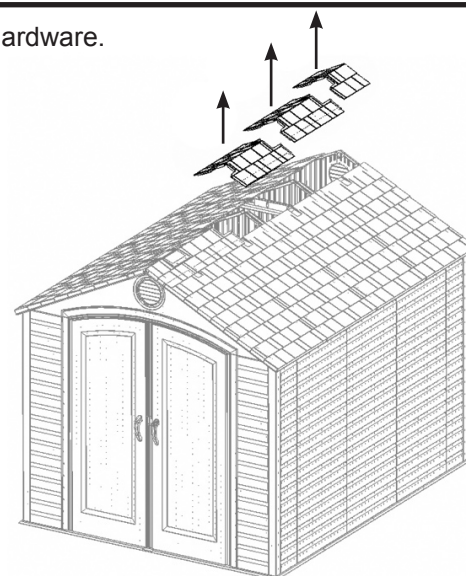
****Save all hardware for re-assembly!****

Note: Keeping hardware separated according to where it came from will make reassembly easier.

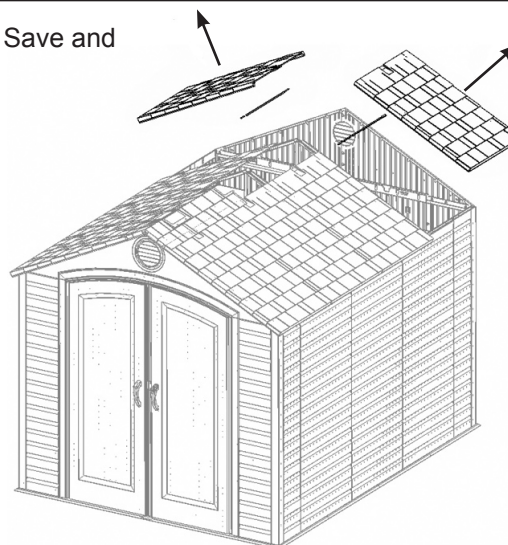
- Q1** a. Remove last three **Skylights**. Save and set aside with hardware.



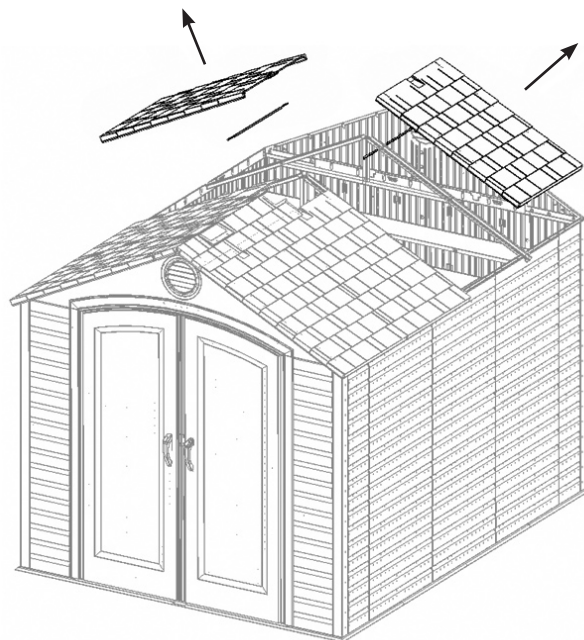
- Q2** a. Remove the last three **Roof Caps**. Save and set aside with hardware.



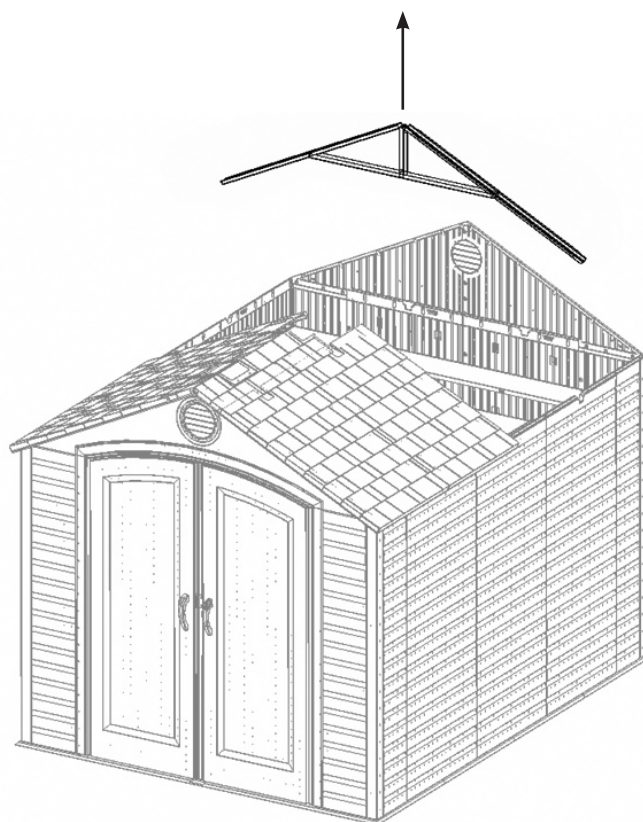
- Q3** a. Remove the back **Roof Panels** and **Roof Support Bars**. Save and set aside with hardware.



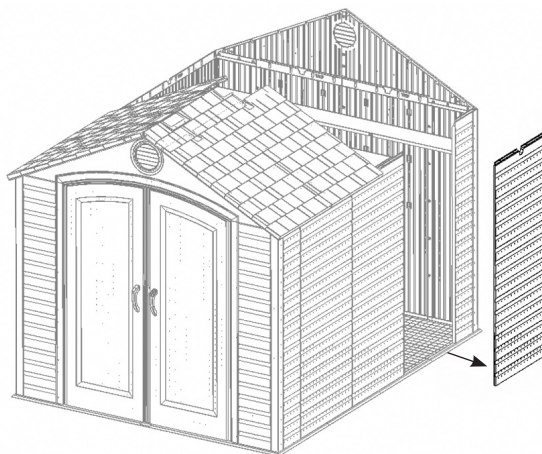
- O4** a. Remove the next **Roof panels** and **Roof support bars**. Save and set aside with hardware.



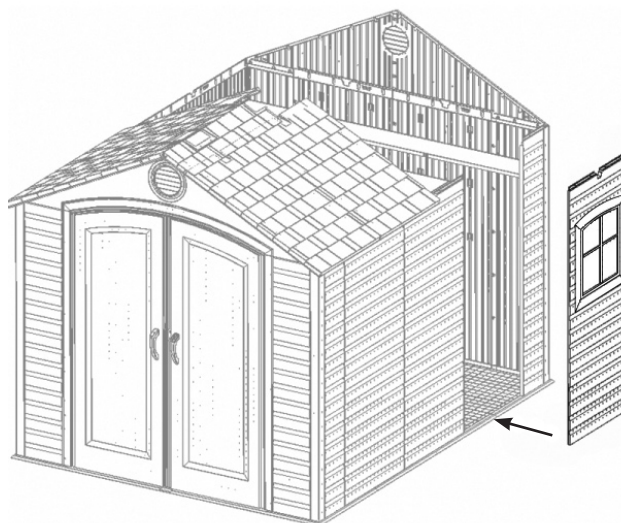
- O5** a. Remove the **Roof Truss**. Save and set aside with hardware.



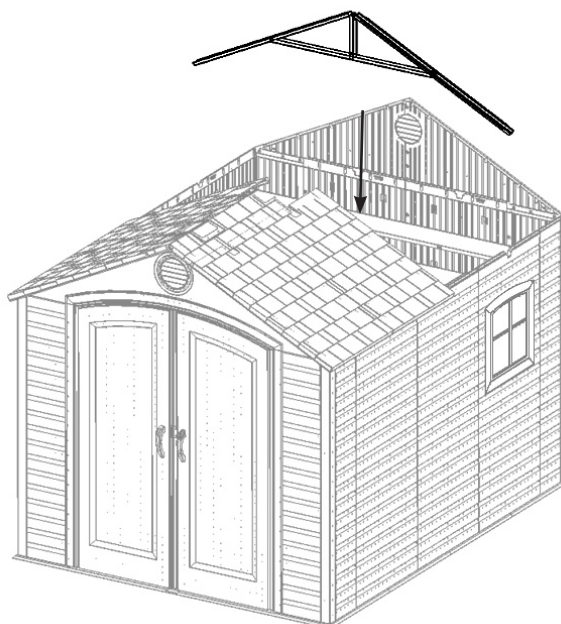
- Q6** a. Remove unwanted **Wall Panel**. Your wall panel may be different than the one shown.



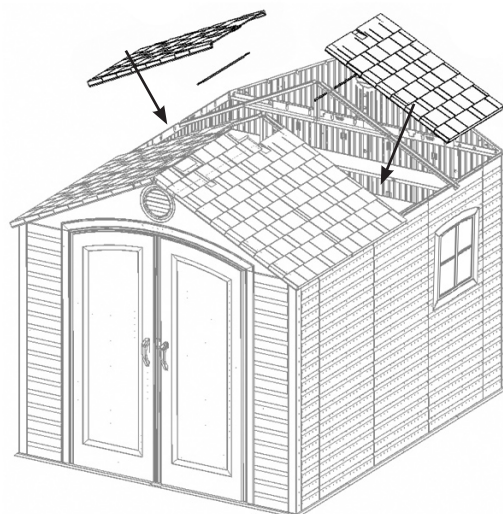
- Q7** a. Insert the new **Window Wall Panel (WA)** in place of the wall panel you removed and attach with **.25" x .625" Screws (TB)**. If you have not yet attached the window to the wall panel, refer to the section Assemble Window on page 3 for instructions.



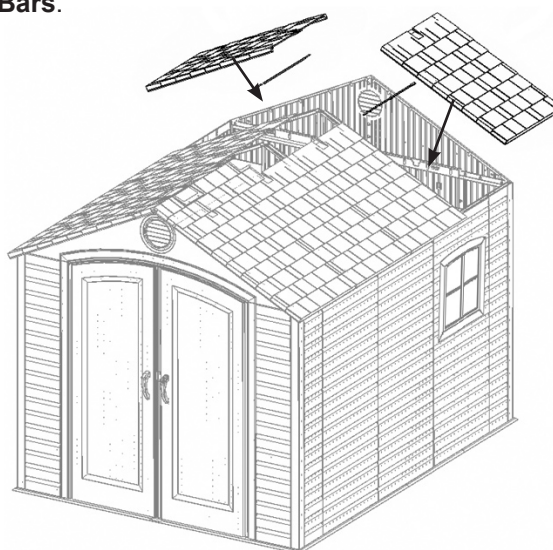
- Q8** a. Replace the **Roof Truss**.



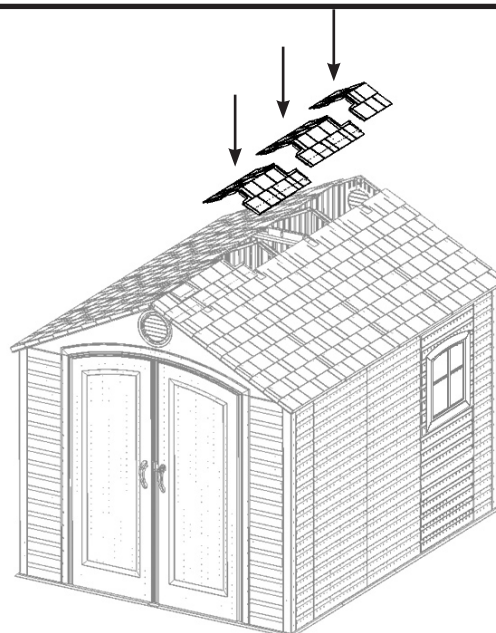
- O9** a. Replace the **Roof Panels** and **Roof Support Bars**.



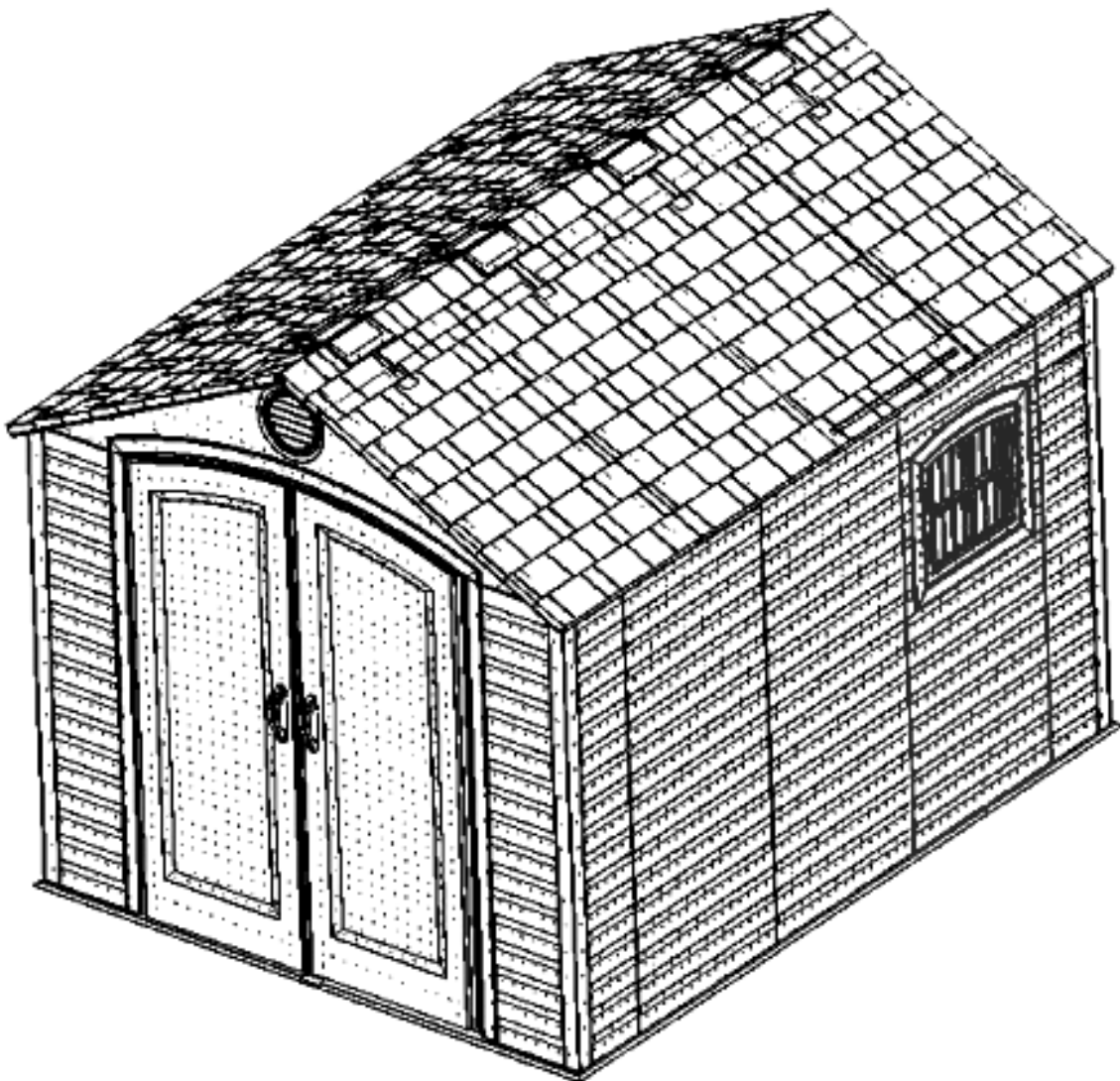
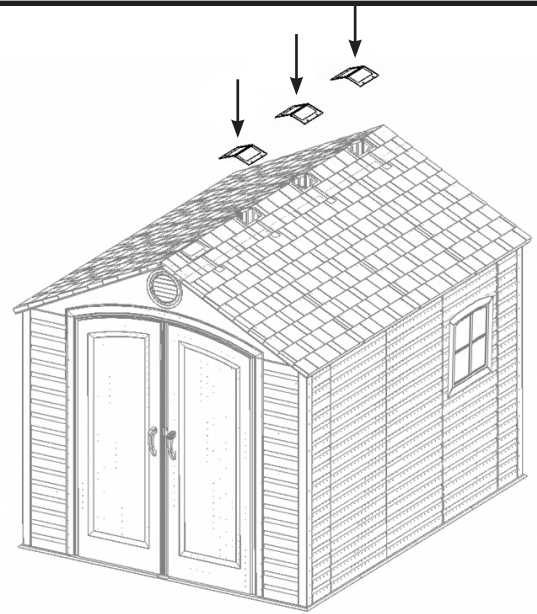

- O11** a. Replace the last three **Roof Caps**.



O12 a. Replace last three **Skylights**.



Option 2: Add Window Wall Panel to New Shed

To add the Window Wall Panel to a new 8' shed, simply insert the window wall panel in place of one of the regular wall panels. Refer to the assembly instructions in the Owners Manual for assistance.

Cleaning and Care

The polyethylene walls and shelves are stain- and solvent resistant. To clean, use a mild soap and a soft-bristled brush. Abrasive cleaning materials may scratch the plastic and are not recommended. Repair scratches or rust spots on the metal by Sanding the affected area lightly; using a rust preventative spray primer; and finally, spraying with a high-gloss spray enamel paint. Avoid placing a direct heat source on or near surfaces unless using a heat barrier.
